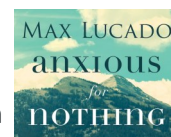


Wednesday Night Dinner

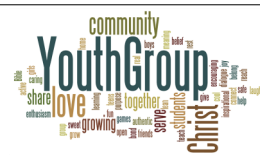
