## Church:

Offering/tithes more than budget—\$4,648 (tithes and offerings \$33,670)

\$4,376 transferred in from operating savings account

A withdrawal from savings occurred because the bank balance at the end of September was \$10,952 and we needed to pay first of month items such as Board of Pensions, etc. that are drafted. The rason the October tithes and offerings are high is because we had a check from a brokerage firm.

#### Preschool:

Personnel expense was \$60,356 - \$5,488 more than budget for month

Two issues: (1) new teacher onboarding and (2) employees not logging in correct hours.

Operating expenses \$3,262 - \$704 more than budget. Book Fair/Fall Festival expenses

Program expenses - \$819 - \$110 more than budget (snack price increase and Fall Festival)
