Haiti Medical Clinic Update



We have received a report of clinic operations for the past 3 months. For November, December and January, the clinic saw 147 patients of all ages, performed 91 tests and dispensed 111 prescriptions. The Clinique de Soutien Communautaire de Beganabe is located in EcoVillage 4 and sees patients 3 days per week. The clinic staff also goes into the countryside to hold mobile clinics once per month. You can provide financial support for the clinic through Good Shepherd by giving to 'Haiti Mobile Clinic'.
