*Profession of Faith (Responsive) John 1:1-5, 9-14, NRSV

Leader: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

People: He was in the beginning with God.

Leader: All things came into being through Him, and without Him not one thing came into being.

People: What has come into being in Him was life, and the life was the light of all people.

Leader: The light shines in the darkness,
