Church:

Tithes, offerings, and other revenue were less than the budget for the month - \$8,616
 Total church expenses were over budget by \$9,785
 Personnel costs more than budgeted by \$6571
 Congregational resources expenses were more than budgeted by \$4516
 Other church expenses were less than budgeted by \$1500
 Congregational resources spent more than the budgeted amount

Preschool:

Preschool Tuition was \$64,722- \$3,778 less than the budget for the month
 Personnel expenses were \$62,240, \$112 less than the budget for the month
 Discounts (credit card fees) were \$1,276, \$859 more than budgeted for the month
 Program Expenses were \$1,993, \$529 more than the budget for the month; much of this was due to the book fair setup.
